




#### SCOTTISH FUN PALACE MAKERS

- 20% OF MAKER TEAMS INVOLVED SOMEONE WITH A DISABILITY
- 40% OF THE TEAMS INVOLVED A MIX OF ETHNIC DIVERSITIES
- 86% OF MAKER TEAMS INVOLVED GETTING NEW PEOPLE INVOLVED. 53% OF THE FUN PALACES DIDN'T REQUIRE TO RAISE MONEY TO ORGANISE THEIR EVENTS.
- 80% AGREED MAKING A FUN PALACE DISCOVERED NEW RESOURCES IN THE COMMUNITY AND 86% DISCOVERED NEW OPPORTUNITIES I PARTNERSHIPS
- AROUND HALF OF THE MAKERS RAN A FUN PALACE AS PART OF THEIR JOB (53%).
- 8 OUT OF THE 17 FUN PALACES DEVELOPED OUT OF A PREVIOUS FUN PALACE OR VOLUNTARY ARTS FESTIVAL MICRO-FUNDED EVENT



#### THE SCOTTISH FUN PALACES INVOLVED...



- 53% OF SCOTTISH FUN PALACES HAD A "HERITAGE!OUR HISTORY" COMPONENTS COMPARED TO 37% NATIONALLY. HOWEVER. FEWER INVOLVED IN MAKER CULTURE (7% VERSUS 27%)
- THERE WAS SLIGHTLY MORE SCIENCE (60% VERSUS 49%) AND TECH (47% VERSUS 37% NATIONALLY) REPRESENTED IN SCOTTISH FUN PALACES
- NEARLY ALL SCIENCE EVENTS HAD BOTH ART & SCIENCE ELEMENTS (60% HIGHER THAN NATIONALLY – 47%)



#### SCOTTISH FUN PALACE PARTICIPANTS


BASED FROM 40 QUESTIONNAIRES FROM 5 OF THE SCOTTISH FUN PALACES. THIS IS SOMETHING WE NEED TO SUPPORT FURTHER IN THE FUTURE TO GET A WIDER EVIDENCE-BASE. SO THIS ANALYSIS IS CONSIDERED EXPLORATORY

- MOST PARTICIPANTS HAD NOT BEEN TO A FUN PALACE BEFORE (98%).
- 45% OF PARTICIPANTS HAD NOT BEEN TO THE VENUE BEFORE
- MANY OF THE PARTICIPANTS WERE ENGAGED IN ARTS (69%) WITH 18% WHO WERE OPEN BUT DIDN'T GO OUT OF THEIR WAY TO ENGAGE IN ARTS.
- HOWEVER. 10% OF PARTICIPANTS WEREN'T NORMALLY INTERESTED IN SCIENCE. AND 55% DIDN'T GO OUT OF THEIR WAY TO ENGAGE IN SCIENCE (AND ONLY 35% WERE ALREADY ENGAGED OR WORKED IN SCIENCE)
- 7.7% OF THE PARTICIPANTS SELF-IDENTIFIED AS FROM A MINORITY ETHNIC GROUP (COMPARED TO 4% IN THE SCOTTISH POPULATION).
- 32% OF PARTICIPANTS DESCRIBED THEMSELVES AS HAVING A DISABILITY OR LONG-TERM HEALTH CONDITION. THIS COMPARES TO 20% OF THE SCOTTISH POPULATION (CENSUS 2011)





#### AGE OF PARTICIPANTS SURVEYED








# POSTCODE ANALYSIS OF PARTICIPANTS SURVEYED & VENUES
